



### **Green School Flag News**



### **Note on School Reports - relating to 1st & 2nd Classes only**

Sten Score Range	What it means.
8-10	Well above average
7	High average
5-6	Average
4	Low average
1-3	Well below average

You will receive your child's end of year school report on 15th June. Please note that school reports of children in 1st & 2nd classes will have results of standardised tests. Standardised tests are used to measure your child's achievement in English reading and Maths. Your child's results will be given as a sten score. Sten scores go from 1 -10. Remember these tests are only an indication of how your child is doing at English reading and maths. No matter what the score is, continue to encourage your child.

If your child has a low score s/he may have difficulties in English reading or maths and may need extra help.
