Weekly schedule

- Each day, we will have a piece of music, based on an animal, and we will have a set “fun task” for children to do!

There is something new to try everyday! :

- **Monday**- Lions - SPHE – Listen to the story
- **Tuesday**- Tortoise- Art- Creating your own tortoise shell
- **Wednesday**- Elephant- SPHE/ Art.
- **Thursday**- Kangaroo- Animal safari game (PE)
- **Friday**-We’re going to the zoo– Creating your own zoo (Geography)

Monday –lions

- This week's theme is the zoo.
- Listen to this piece of music – which animal do you think this piece is trying to create a picture of?

- Can you think of times you had to be brave like a lion? Can you roar like one?



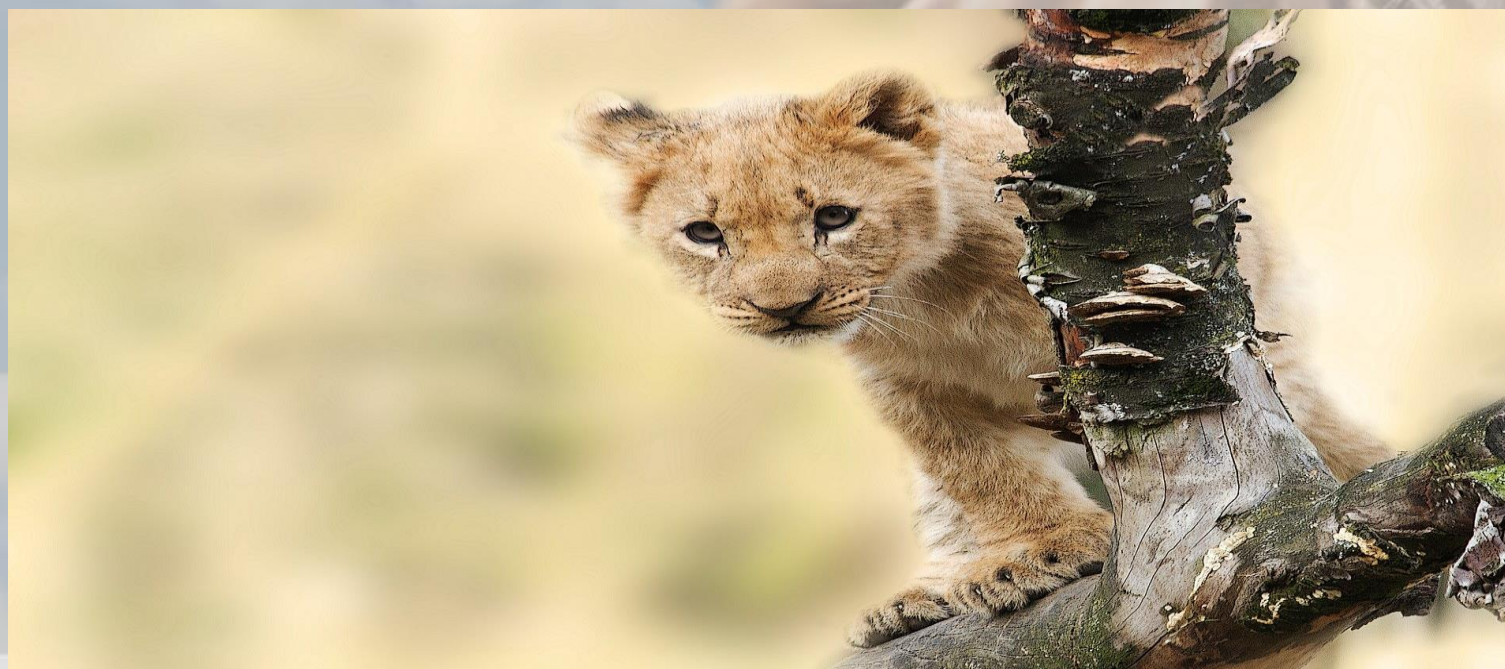
Activity-

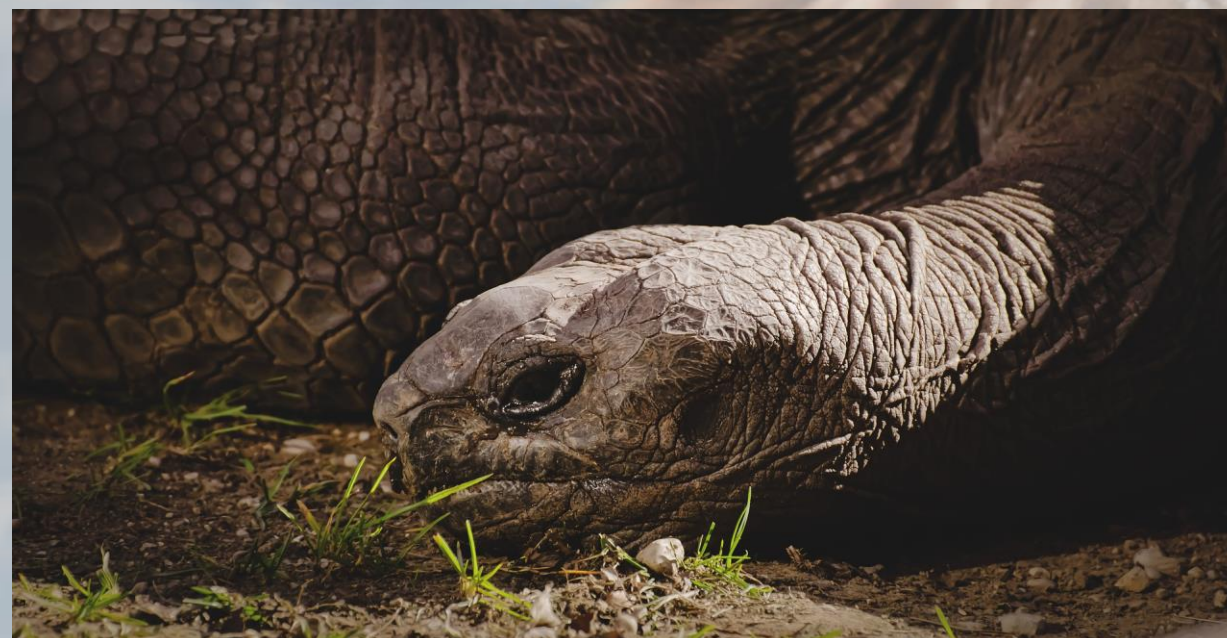
- What did they call the lion? What was his other name?
- Was the lion nice? What type of lion was he?
- Why was he not nice to the mouse?
- What did the mouse do to help the lion?
- Did the lion change? How did he change?
- Did he treat the mouse better? How?

What do you think this story is about? What is the lesson?



Tuesday- Tortoise

- Again, listen to this piece of music – which animal do you think this piece is trying to create a picture of?

- It's a Tortoise –Think of times when you saw one. what do they look like? What do you know about them?
- Can you think of times you had to go very slow like a tortoise? Can you move slowly like one?



Activity- tortoise shell

- Design a tortoise shell – create your own unique tortoise shell with lots of colours and patterns.
- Look at the pictures and look at the different shells they can have.



Wednesday -elephant

- Again, listen to this piece of music – which animal do you think this piece is trying to create a picture of?

- It's an elephant –Think of times when you saw one. What do they look like? What do you know about them?
- Can you think of how elephants move? What noises do they make? How do they use their trunks?

- Listen to the last piece of music this week– which animal do you think this piece is trying to create a picture of?
